## "GENERAL INFORMATION FOR EXPORTING SMALL ANIMALS FROM PANAMA"

## I. <u>Basic requirements</u>:

Each passenger that wants to depart from Panama to either country with their pets (dogs, cats and ferrets) should have the following documents:

- 1. Vaccines record card or certificate with valid date, specifically rabies.
- 2. **Health certificate** of the pet issue by a clinician veterinary doctor.
- 3. **Phytozoosanitary Exportation License** issue by official veterinary doctor of Agricultural Ministery (MIDA) at "Ventanilla Unica" located in Plaza Edison of Ricardo J. Alfaro Way (Tumba Muerto). Phone: (507) 560 5890.

**If you are coming back before 30 days**, you can present the true copy of the Phytozoosanitary Exportation License with the returning stamp, until 30 days of the document issue date.

## **II. Important Note:**

Since each country has their own specific requirements for the arrival of pets, we recommend to get inform with the airline, consulate or the sanitary authority of the country of final destination to confirm the requirements demand.
